

# Renown Iris



## *Iris 'Renown'*

- **Use:** This hard-to-find white variety is a solid garden performer, a white blooming workhorse for the garden. You can count on flowers to attract hummingbirds and butterflies. They're resistant to deer, gophers and drought! What a winner!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 32-38" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Graceful, thick, long blades.
- **Flower:** Renown blooms with billowy white **fragrant** flowers that tumble through the garden in the spring and fall.
