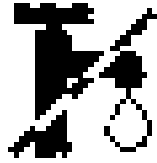


Silverband Iris



Iris ensata 'Silverband'



Sun loving and very easy to grow!

- **Use:** Adapts to most soil types and tolerates drought well. Quite popular because of its variegated foliage. Flowers are excellent for cutting. After the plant has finished flowering just remove the flower spike... don't cut the plant back to the ground. All parts of Iris are poisonous.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 28" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9b Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Broad, creamy white-and-green, vertically striped foliage
- **Flower:** In late spring, each clump is topped with attractive, pale lavender-blue flowers.
