

# Breakers Bearded Iris

## *Iris germanica* 'Breakers'

- **Use:** Superb blue bearded iris with striking ruffled edges. Make sure to plant this eye-catching and soothing selection near patios, porches or other outdoor sitting areas. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. We suggest 6 or more hours of direct sunlight for best blooming. Poor drainage is a death sentence. Planting them on a slope or in raised beds helps to ensure good drainage. Mix in some composted organic matter to improve drainage in heavy clay soils. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 34-36" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space plants 18" - 24" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3a-9b; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. They have a fine strap like foliage that remains evergreen in warmer climates.
- **Flower:** Mid-late season blooms; medium blue with billowing ruffled edges. Prolific bloomer with 8-10 buds per stem; reblooms.
