

Gold Variegated Bearded Iris



Sun loving and very easy to grow!

Iris pallida 'Aurea Variegata'

- **Use:** Adapts to most soil types and tolerates drought well. Quite popular because of its variegated foliage. Flowers are excellent for cutting. After the plant has finished flowering just remove the flower spike... don't cut the plant back to the ground. All parts of Iris are poisonous.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 30" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-7b Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When the golden striped foliage is backlit by the afternoon sun, the effect is glorious
- **Flower:** In late May and early June, the vigorous sturdy clumps are topped with light blue, crested iris flowers.
