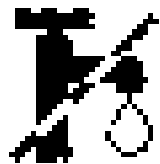


# Cape Cod Boys Siberian Iris



**Sun loving and very easy to grow!**



## *Iris siberica* 'Cape Cod Boys'

- **Use:** Siberian irises are hailed for their elegant, delicate flowers and disease resistance. They perform admirably in the sunny to partially shady garden, but need plenty of water throughout the season to continue looking their best. In naturalized settings, they are particularly effective around water features. They can also be grown under Black Walnut trees since they are not effected by juglone. Siberian Irises bloom before Japanese Irises but after Tall Bearded Irises.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 30-32" tall and 24" wide. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. When it is not flowering, the attractive, wide blue-green leaf blades will catch your eye.
- **Flower:** Just like the famous shore community of Cape Cod, this Siberian Iris will make you think of beaches and the ocean. Periwinkle blue flowers have darker blue veining that intensifies into a defined pattern at the end of the petals. Prominent clear lemon yellow signals complete the look. This variety blooms for a long time.
