

Blue Flag Iris



Sun loving, easy to grow, deer resistant, and can withstand up to 4" of water in a pond or drainage ditch!

Iris versicolor

- **Use:** These lacy blue and violet blossoms are a must for every garden! Long arching leaves grow 3-4' in length, especially in shallow water. An intricate creation that can grace your own created landscape. Beautiful! Flowers are excellent for cutting. After the plant has finished flowering just remove the flower spike... don't cut the plant back to the ground. All parts of Iris are deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Tolerates up to 4" of water
- **Growth:** Grows 30" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** In late May and early June, the vigorous sturdy clumps are topped with blue flowers.
