This vigorous plant tolerates heat and humidity, flowering from spring till frost.

Isotoma (Laurentia) axillaris 'Beth's Blue'

- **Use:** Beloved for its unique star-shaped, lavender flowers and interesting texture, this plant plays well with others in combination containers and landscapes. This Laurentia is quite tolerant of heat and humidity, blooming even through the most intense southern summers. It is a superb bedding choice, blooming right down to the ground! Use in pots, window boxes, landscaping and combinations
- **Exposure/Soil:** The preference is full to partial sun and moist soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 12-14" tall and 10-14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7a-11b Tender Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen, Thin green foliage is grass-like.
- **Flower:** Star shaped lavender-blue flowers. Once it gets started, it blooms right on through the heat of summer until frost.
