Juncus inflexus 'Blue Dart'

- **Use:** We've taken ornamental grass growing and made it simple . The linear blue foliage of Blue Dart has a strong vertical habit that makes it a faster, more reliable alternative to spike dracaena. A great choice for adding texture to small containers and in-ground plantings. Very adaptable to a wide range of conditions, including standing water and drought. Makes a great indoor lifestyle plant, and can even be used as a water plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun- part sun. Loves wet soil and water garden or bog conditions, but also takes normal soil conditions.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-16" tall and 10-14" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Leaves are wound tight as they emerge, and begin to relax as they mature. Stems may be trimmed back hard in spring.
- **Flower:** Flowers are brownish and insignificant.
