High Roller Hot Poker









Commonly called Red Hot Poker or Torch Lily for their tall flower spikes. These South Africa natives offer tremendous garden value by combining grass-like foliage with tall flower scapes. An excellent perennial for the middle of the border.

Kniphofia 'High Roller'

- <u>Use</u>: Member of the Winner's Club® Collection The sky's the limit on this tropical looking plant! Coral orange flowers open creamy white on perfectly formed spikes. The beautiful bicolor flowers are produced above a large clump of foliage and blooms for many weeks beginning in early to midsummer. The spiky flowers and upright habit gives a very unique drama to your landscape, with rebloom extending the color late into the season. This one is especially attractive to hummingbirds and doesn't appeal to deer. Makes a great cut flower, patio container or landscape plant. Long tap root gives good drought tolerance.
- **<u>Exposure/Soil</u>**: Plant in full sun to partial sun(6+hours of afternoon sun). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to dry slightly between waterings. Drought tolerant once established
- <u>Growth</u>: Fast growing evergreen foliage 24-30in. high, flower spikes 36 to 48 in. tall and a width of 24-28".
- *Hardiness: Zone* 5b-9; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- <u>Foliage</u>: Semi-evergreen. Grass-like foliage provides textural contrast to bold-leaved perennials
- <u>Flower:</u> Coral orange flowers open creamy white on tall, spiky stems. Reblooming.
