

Orange Blaze Red Hot Poker



Kniphofia uvaria 'Orange Blaze'

- **Use:** Members of the PYROMANIA® Collection are a rainbow of hot colors including red, orange, and yellow. The spiky flowers and upright habit gives a very unique drama to your landscape, with rebloom extending the color late into the season. This one is especially attractive to hummingbirds and doesn't appeal to deer. Makes a great cut flower, patio container or landscape plant. Long tap root gives good drought tolerance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun(6+hours of afternoon sun). Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Allow soil to dry slightly between waterings. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Fast growing evergreen foliage 18-24in. high, flower spikes 24 to 30 in. tall and a width of 18-24”.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5b-9; Perennial. Very heat and drought tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Grass-like foliage provides textural contrast to bold-leaved perennials
- **Flower:** Bright orange flowers are densely packed onto the flower spike, and flowers are proportionate to the foliage. One of the most compact of the collection.
