Lamium maculatum 'Dark Purple'

- <u>Use:</u> Silvery white leaves with green edges form a lush ground-cover that is topped by charming deep purple flowers in summer.
 Brightens shady areas, and tolerates dry shade conditions when established. Beautiful trailing from mixed containers or used to edge borders. If you're looking for a uniquely colorful groundcover that maintains some color even during the winter months,
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade! Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer in late spring. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Water under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** This compact type grows 6-12" tall and plant 10-12" apart.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-9 Perennial.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Semi-evergreen; The leave have serrated edges and tiny veins that are highlighted with various shades of green.
- <u>Flower</u>: Produces a spring bloom of petite, purple blossoms that repeat throughout the summer. The effect of the tiny spots of lavender against the green edged, silver leaves is breathtaking!
