Use as a groundcover for cover shady banks. Also excellent used in containers.



Lamium maculatum 'Pink Pewter'

- **Use:** Lamiums are a perfect deer resistant groundcover to brighten a partly sunny, semi-shady spot. A great performer. Attractive foliage. Scalloped blue-green margins and shimmering silvery centers of Pink Pewter brighten shady gardens and create a dramatic backdrop for the masses of small, tubular soft pink flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun to shade! Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer in late spring. Prefers to be kept moist and likes rich soil. Water under leaves and flowers for best results.
- **Growth:** This compact type grows 6" tall and plant 16" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8 Perennial.
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen; 1- to 2-inch-wide leaves are silvery white with green edges and have a quilted appearance. Vigorous grower but non invasive. Shear back to 4" to 6" if it gets leggy or cut back to new leaves at base of plant in midsummer. Can be divided as needed in spring or fall.
- **Flower:** *Clusters of soft salmon-pink flowers appear in spring, then continue off and on until fall.*
