Lantana 'Anne Marie'

- **Use:** Lantana is an excellent choice for beds or containers. Attractive foliage is topped with vividly colored flowers. The foliage of some cultivars is lemon scented... other's may have prickly stems. The brightly colored flowers of Lantana are excellent for attracting hummingbirds and Butterflies. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 1-2 feet tall, to 2-3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** This compact form has a dense bushy habit and a profusion of multi-colored flowers all season. The flowers start yellow, then change to orange-pink, then change to fuchsia-red. All different colors usually appear at the same time. A favorite of butterflies and hummingbirds.

Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.
