

Bandana Red Improved Lantana



Lantana x 'Bandana Red Improved'

- **Use:** If you are looking for a tough plant it's hard to beat lantana. Lantana are heat tolerant, use little to no supplemental water in the landscape, will tolerate less than ideal soils and usually don't need to be deadheaded. If you are looking for a plant that will thrive on neglect, lantana is the champ. Useful as substitute for annuals in flower beds or containers. Attracts butterflies. Tolerates heat.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 12-16" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8b-11, Annual/ Tender Perennial. Mulch well in the winter. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green-lance leaves. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Technically, the blooms change colors as they age. 'Bandana Red' opens with a deep chocolaty-red that matures to the true red that we like. Orange begins to appear in the flower as it ages, and the bloom finishes with a pumpkin orange center; sometimes that center can lighten to yellow.
