- **Use:** Bigger and Bolder! Bandolero is a vigorous Lantana that look great in landscape beds and fill large containers quickly with show stopping performance all season long. This easy-to-grow plant thrives in full hot sun from dawn to dusk and tolerates heat, drought and humidity making it the perfect plant for that landscape area, either as a focal point or mass planting, next to your brick wall or paved driveway or other hot spots where few plants can survive. In addition the multicolored, self-cleaning, very fragrant 2" bloom clusters add beautiful color to large containers including hanging baskets, window boxes and planters. Easy-to-grow and maintain fragrant Bandolero Lantana has long-lasting, colorful blooms, attracts bees, butterflies, and hummingbirds, and is deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 18-24" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8b/9-11, Annual/ Tender Perennial. Mulch well in the winter. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green-lance leaves. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** A cheery mix of yellow and hot pink flowers from spring until fall.
