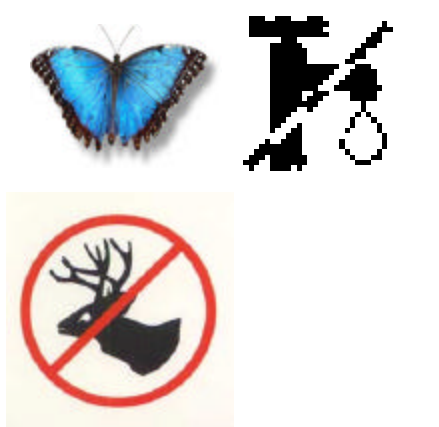


# Chapel Hill Yellow Lantana



## *Lantana x 'Chapel Hill Yellow'*

- **Use:** Profuse color year-round from rich orange-red flowers! Useful as substitute for annuals in flower beds or containers. Excellent low hedge or accent shrub. Attracts butterflies. Tolerates heat.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 16” tall, to 2-3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7-11, Perennial. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Showy clusters of lemon yellow flowers through the season.

Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance. Has won numerous awards from UGA for plant vigor!
