

Confetti Lantana



Lantana camara 'Confetti'

- **Use:** Tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Shrub-type Lantana that can get 2-3' in height with a 6-8' spread. Should be spaced every 24-36" when planting.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** The blooms are tri-colored consisting of yellow, pink, and purple to wine colors that will fade with age and are great for attracting butterflies.

**Heat and sun tolerant;
flowers all season; low
