

Florida Fuschia Lantana



Lantana 'Florida Fuschia'

- **Use:** Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Does not tolerate wet feet or will rot in winter.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 18" tall by 24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender Perennial. Do not cut back stems until late April after winter is passed. Come sup in May
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Showy clusters of yellow and pink flowers until late October frosts.

Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.
