## Ham & Eggs Lantana





An old, sterile cultivar that has been passed along in the Southeast for many years.



## Lantana 'Ham & Eggs'

- Use: Tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and dry banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. Topped from early summer until fall with flowers that open pink and then develop a central pattern of flowers which are cream with a golden eye...a summer delight for hummingbirds. Occasionally, there is a slight tinge of orange in the flower...a real show stopper! Deer resistant.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun- part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Does not tolerate wet feet.
- Growth: Mounded form to 3 -5 ft tall, to 6 ft wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 7b-10, Perennial. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- Foliage: Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- *Flower:* A sterile cultivar that has clusters of deep pink flowers with a central pattern of soft yellow blooms with darker yellow eyes.
