

Heartland Neon Lantana Basket



Heat tolerant, drought tolerant, deer resistant, little to no need for deadheading, versatile, fragrant, attractive to butterflies and hummingbirds, what is there not to love?

Lantana x 'Heartland Neon'

- **Use:** If you are looking for a tough plant it's hard to beat lantana. Lantana are heat tolerant, use little to no supplemental water in the landscape, will tolerate less than ideal soils and usually don't need to be deadheaded. If you are looking for a plant that will thrive on neglect, lantana is the champ. Useful as substitute for annuals in flower beds or containers. Attracts butterflies. Tolerates heat. They are perfect for a full sun location in need of their tropical colors.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 18-24" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8b-11, Annual/ Tender Perennial. Mulch well in the winter. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green-lance leaves. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** The large rounded clusters of flowers open a bright yellow and quickly deepen through shades of orange and red into magenta and purple tones.
