## ***Lantana x 'Hot Blooded'***

- **Use:** If you pick just one, pick this one! Naturally well branched with more vigor than Bandana® making it a great choice for gardens across the country. Medium-sized flowers with amazing color coverage. Sure to brighten up the landscape and yet compact enough to use in containers. Excellent flower power producing a heavy display of nectar rich flowers from spring until frost. Useful as substitute for annuals in flower beds or containers. Attracts butterflies. Tolerates heat.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Grows 14-16” tall and 24-30” wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8b-11, Annual/ Tender Perennial. Mulch well in the winter. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Orange, dark-red, and a hint of orange-yellow in the center. A sterile selection that has been a top-pick in development trial which means they bloom longer and more intensely than types trying to set fruit.
