

New Gold Lantana



Lantana 'New Gold'

- **Use:** Lantana are very heat tolerant. It is a tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. They also thrive in our dry summers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 8-12" tall, to 2-3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch with 2" of bark or pine straw around the plant.
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Yellow blossoms from April until frost. In fall do not cut back the dead stems! Wait until April the following spring when you see new leaves emerging. Then you may cut back the old stems.
