

Red Spread Lantana



Lantana 'Red Spread'

- **Use:** Tropical appearing shrub, but heat hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 1-2 feet tall, to 2-3 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Scented leaves. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Produces clusters flowers that open orange and then darken to deep rich red on a mounding to spreading plant from spring until fall.

Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.
