Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.





Lantana 'Red Spread'

- <u>Use:</u> Tropical appearing shrub, but heat hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- *Exposure/Soil:* Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- Growth: Mounded form to 1-2 feet tall, to 2-3 feet wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 8-11, Tender perennial. <u>Do not cut back</u> <u>stems until April.</u> Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant
- *Foliage:* Deciduous. Scented leaves. Cutting grown.
- *Flower:* Produces clusters flowers that open orange and then darken to deep rich red on a mounding to spreading plant from spring until fall.
