Lantan Luscious® Series

- <u>Use:</u> Tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. Sandy well drained soil preferred. Not tolerant of clay or will rot in winter.
- <u>Growth</u>: Trailing form of Lantana and will only get 12-20" in height with a 3 foot spread, depending on each cultivar.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 9a-11, Annual/Possible Perennial. <u>Do not cut</u>
 <u>back stems until April of following spring</u>. Be patient as they
 might not sprout until May! Water in the hollow stems will freeze out
 the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant
 - **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Lantana's foliage may change to a red to purple color in the colder months.
 - <u>Flower:</u> The blooms appear in masses from spring to fall, and are great for attracting butterflies. Extremely heat tolerant. Beloved by butterflies.
