

White Star Creeper



This vigorous plant tolerates heat and humidity, flowering from spring till frost.



Laurentia fluviatilis 'Alba' (Isotoma fluviatilis)

- **Use:** Excellent as a lawn substitute in shady areas, excellent between stepping stones, under roses, around ponds and decks. Super easy to grow, can bloom spring to frost and easy to maintain! Cold and heat hardy and generally left alone by deer or rabbits.
- **Exposure/Soil:** The preference is full to partial shade and moist soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Height of 2-4". And continues to trail along the ground.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous, Dainty leaves.
- **Flower:** Starry white blossoms from late spring until fall.
