

# Annet English Lavender

## *Lavandula angustifolia* 'Annet'

- **Use:** Large royal purple flower spikes crowd together on well-branched, bushy plants for showy impact. Incredibly fragrant flowers and foliage are ideal additions to sachets and potpourris. ... Many feel Lavender scent places them in a relaxed state. A great cultivar for cutting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. **Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY!** Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage. Good drainage, pH, and air circulation are key to success.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-18" tall , 16-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5a-9a; Perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Evergreen in warmer climates. Thin, gray-green leaves that boast a sweet fragrance. Strong sturdy stems for cutting.
- **Flower:** Produces large dark purple blooms that are tighter together, delivering more color and fewer airy gaps. Prune and hang upside down to dry if desired.
