

# Eternal Elegance LaDiva Lavender



## *Lavandula angustifolia* 'LaDiva Eternal Elegance'

- **Use:** La Diva Eternal Elegance Lavender is a complete breakthrough for *Lavandula angustifolia* (English Lavender) types with earlier flowering, blooming months before most English Lavender. Incredibly fragrant flowers and foliage are ideal additions to sachets and potpourris. ... Many feel Lavender scent places them in a relaxed state. Use it as a pot plant, alone or with other sun-loving herbs and perennials. It looks beautiful in the garden, mass-planted, or as a specimen. Its great size makes it ideal for edging gardens and walkways. Lavender makes gorgeous fresh and dried cut flowers. Just a sprig or two will add considerable charm and outstanding fragrance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. **Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY!** Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage. Good drainage, pH, and air circulation are key to success.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-14" tall , 12-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Evergreen in warmer climates. Thin, gray-green leaves that boast a sweet fragrance
- **Flower:** Compared to a traditional *angustifolia*, blooms earlier and has more vibrant branching with loads of fabulously fragrant dark blackberry-purple flowers. A superior selection, it blooms heavily from spring through fall. It perfumes the air with its outstanding fragrance. Prune and hang upside down to dry if desired.
