

Munstead English Lavender



Lavandula angustifolia 'Munstead'

- **Use:** Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY! Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-11, Tender perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Fragrant purple spikes of blossoms in summer. Used for relaxing scent!
