

Scent Blue English Lavender



Lavandula angustifolia 'Scent Blue'

- **Use:** This compact, aromatic English lavender will be the first to bloom with deep indigo-purple flower spikes. A versatile, undemanding little evergreen shrub that thrives in warm, sunny spots. Ideal for containers, low borders, and rock gardens. A must-have for Mediterranean or cottage gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. **Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY!** Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage. Good drainage, pH, and air circulation are key to success.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 12 to 16 in. tall, 10 to 12 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Evergreen in warmer climates. Broad, gray-green-cream variegated leaves that boast a sweet fragrance
- **Flower:** Produces dark blue blooms that are tighter together, delivering more color and fewer airy gaps. Prune and hang upside down to dry if desired.

A versatile small lavender valuable for dry slopes, banks and rock gardens. Exceptional component of Mediterranean style gardens both formal and casual. Suitable for xeriscape or wild gardens. Equally suited to traditional mixed borders with perennials and flowering shrubs provided soil is well drained. Plant closely in groups.
