

Anouk Spanish Lavender

- **Use:** Unusual two-toned flowers are framed by its silvery foliage making it a garden standout. Dark plum flowers are topped by violet flags, like butterfly wings. Very fragrant it's a good choice for containers, patios, and porches where you can enjoy it up close.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. **Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. NO RED CLAY!** Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-10, Tender perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage: Deciduous.** Scented leaves are an aromatic grey-green foliage.
- **Flower:** Highly fragrant, keep it deadheaded for non-stop blooms. Fragrant deep purple blooms topped by cheery lavender flags.
