

# Phenomenal Lavender



## *Lavandula intermedia* 'Phenomenal'

- **Use:** At last, a lavender truly adapted to our hot, humid summers and tough winters! Phenomenal is a groundbreaking hardy cultivar, truly a breeding breakthrough that every American gardener will love. This new American introduction refuses to die back in winter, tolerates extreme heat and humidity without melting out, resists rot, and stands up to other foliar diseases that can make Lavender a challenge to grow. In other words, it conquers all the stumbling blocks that have held lavender back in gardens across the country!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. **Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. AMMEND RED CLAY!** Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage.
- **Growth:** Grows 2-3' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness Zone** 4-8; Tender perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** The light purple flowers are very fragrant, and dry beautifully for potpourri.
