- **Use:** This unique new Spanish Lavender is topped with cheerful flags above small colorful flowers. Unlike other Lavender of this type, this new addition will flower during the Summer months in the mid-South and North, as well as mid-Winter in the Deep South. Not only is lavender a bee and butterfly magnet, its fragrance has been linked to health and wellness, it makes an excellent gift, and its blooms offer craft-minded folks a multitude of DIY projects. Add to those benefits a pleasing color, garden habit and low-maintenance nature and you've got a winner for the next generation of gardeners.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. **Soil must be sandy and have a pH of 7, so add lime. AMMEND RED CLAY!** Keep water off the leaves, water under foliage.
- **Growth:** Compact growth, 13-15 inches tall and 10-12" wide.
- **Hardiness Zone 7a-9a;**Perennial. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Deciduous/ Sem-evergreen, Fine, fragrant leaves of silvery gray-green cover the plants all year around. In drier weather the leaves become more linear and needle-like
- **Flower:** Fragrant, rich royal purple, white, pink, or wine colored (in the series) flower spikes rise above the dense mound of fine, gray-green foliage, providing months of seasonal color. Trim off old blooms to promote the most flowering.
