- **Use:** Fluffy-looking flowers on compact, well-branched plants make a real garden showstopper. Shasta Daisy for mass plantings in garden beds, or in sunny patio containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Uniformly compact plants grow 8-10 in. tall and 8-12 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green, toothy foliage provides excellent contrast.
- **Flower:** Large white flowers bloom are evenly all over compact, well-branched plants. Reblooms, providing flowers over a long period. from summer to fall. Deadheading will keep this one blooming for a long season.
