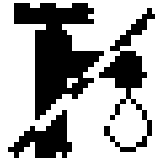


Artic Snow Shasta Daisy

- **Use:** Shasta Daisies are all-time favorites for the perennial border. The cheery flowers begin to appear in early summer and continue on for several months if faithfully deadheaded. Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 18-20" tall in bloom. Spreads to 16-18" in width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Starts pumping out the white daisy blooms as early as late April and keeps popping until fall!
