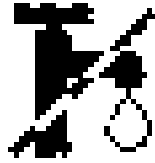


Amazing Daisies® 'Banana Cream II' Shasta Daisy

- **Use:** This improvement on the classic 'Banana Cream' takes all the characteristics that gardeners love and kicks it up a notch. Just like the original, flower buds are lemon yellow and eventually brighten to creamy white. Improvements include being more floriferous, holding the yellow color longer, a more appealing habit, and earlier to start flowering. Shasta Daisies are all-time favorites for the perennial border. The cheery flowers begin to appear in early summer and continue on for several months if faithfully deadheaded. Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 20-24" tall in bloom. Spreads to 20-22" in width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Lemon yellow flower buds open to creamy white flowers. A very floriferous plant that has an extra long bloom time in summer. Blooms spring to fall frosts. Deadheading increases flower count.
