

# Madonna Shasta Daisy



Shastas mix so effortlessly with other grasses and perennials that no garden should be without them!



## *Leucanthemum × superbum Double Madonna'*

- **Use:** Fleuroselect Gold Medal Winner, Europe's top prize. This new hybrid dwarf daisy with the ability to continue producing lovely bright white, yellow-centered, 3 in. flowers throughout summer and into fall. A first year flowering perennial, winter hardy to zone 5. An excellent Shasta Daisy for mass plantings in garden beds, or in sunny patio containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Uniformly compact plants grow 8-10 in. tall and 8-12 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green foliage
- **Flower:** Pure white flowers with yellow centers are produced on top of fading flowers from summer to fall.
