Leucanthemum x superbum 'Snow Lady'

- <u>Use:</u> Will make an excellent, long-lasting cut flower! 'Snow Lady' was the 1991 All-America award winner. An outstanding dwarf form with large, single, long-lasting, pure white flowers that attract butterflies. Excellent for perennial borders, and containers. Resistant to heat, drought and humidity.
 - Exposure/Soil: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- Growth: Fast growing to 12" tall in bloom. Spreads to 15-18" in width.
- *Hardiness:* 4-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Cheery single, white flowers late spring to summer. Cut off old flowers to promote more flowering.
