- <u>Use:</u> The Sweet Daisy series boasts a compact and tidy habit with flowers in abundance. 'Izabel' is extremely floriferous with soft yellow flowers up to 5" across with yellow centers. Great for the front of the border or in containers on the patio. Deer and rabbit resistant. Makes great cut flowers.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- <u>Growth</u>: Fast growing to 10-12" tall in bloom. Spreads to 10-12" in width.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Disease resistant foliage is green, narrow and serrated.
- **Flower:** Masses of beautiful yellow daisy flowers with gold eyes at the ends of the stems from early to fall, which are most effective when planted in groupings. Deadhead old flowers for the most reblooms.
