- <u>Use:</u> The Sweet Daisy series boasts a compact and tidy habit with flowers in abundance. 'Rebecca' is the newest addition to the series with flowers having several layers of frilly white petals with bright yellow centers. Great for the front of the border or in containers on the patio. Deer and rabbit resistant. Makes good cut flowers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 10-12" tall in bloom. Spreads to 10-12" in width.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 4-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- Foliage: Green leaves. Deciduous.
- <u>Flower:</u> This selection from the Sweet Daisy series has umbrellashaped, white flowers with frilled edges and bright yellow button eye. Removing faded flowers will greatly increase the blooming time.
