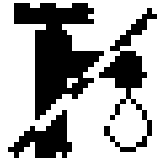


Western Star Taurus Shasta Daisy



Leucanthemum × superbum 'Western Star Taurus'

Shastas mix so effortlessly with other grasses and perennials that no garden should be without them!

- **Use:** A small-statured Shasta Daisy with large, yellow-centered white flowers on short stems above glossy, dark green foliage. Suitable for containers or the front of a border. These long lasting beauties are great for cutting and attractive to butterflies. Suited to mass plantings, beds or borders. Strong-stemmed, well-branched plants provide extended flowering period starting in late spring. Mingles nicely with perennials or annuals in a mixed container. Great for the front of the border or in containers on the patio.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 14-20" tall in bloom. Spreads to 18-24" in width.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 4-9; Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green leaves
- **Flower:** Very large, pure white blooms from spring until fall. Prune off old flowers for best repeat blooming.
