Shastas mix so effortlessly with other perennials that no garden should be without them!

Leucanthemum × superbum 'White Lion'

- **Use:** White Lion Shasta Daisy is a perennial offering early spring to late summer interest. Long and heavy blooming, this plant sets daisies with white rays surrounding a golden yellow center. Borne singly on stiff stems, the flowers make excellent, long-lasting cuts and attract tons of butterflies to the garden. Stays compact in mixed containers and in the garden. Shasta daisies are classic cottage and cutting garden plants and a mainstay in the perennial border. Enjoy 3-seasons of flowers without sacrificing space! This plant is generally considered deer and rabbit resistant and a good choice for gardens near wild or rural areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Compact and fast growing to 8-10" tall in bloom. Spreads to 8-12" in width.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3b-9a Perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Green leaves.
- **Flower:** These classic daisies have umbrella-shaped, white flowers with smooth edges and bright yellow button eye from spring until fall. Removing faded flowers will greatly increase the blooming time.
