## *Leucanthemum x superbum* 'Crazy Daisy'

- **Use:** No two blooms are just alike on this incredible just-for-fun Shasta Daisy! Excellent for perennial borders, and containers. Resistant to heat, drought and humidity. Blooms nonstop from late spring until fall, just snip off the old blossoms.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 24-28" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9 perennial. Very heat tolerant! Mulch around plant in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** The 2 1/2-inch blooms are fully double -- in fact, they're so crammed with petals you might be tempted to call them triple! -- and boast solid white petals around a small, buttery center. Beyond that, every bloom is distinct. The petals take just about every form you can imagine, from quilled to frilled to twisted to flat! On a plant in full bloom, this creates an unbelievably lush, chaotic effect!
