

Little Peach Lewisia



Lewisia longipetala 'Little Peach'

- **Use:** An enchanting perennial with dainty, daisy-like blooms held in airy clusters and succulent evergreen foliage. Requires excellent drainage and dry soil after flowering. Just the right plant tucked into rock gardens, borders or used as edging. Native to California & Oregon.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun to part sun. Requires sharp drainage. If water is able to sit in the crown, it will cause the plant to rot. NO RED CLAY! This strain is deer resistant and drought tolerant as well.
- **Growth:** Grows 6" high and 10-12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; The plant has a fleshy, spoon-shaped leaves, arranged in flat rosettes.
- **Flower:** 1" wide flowers in peachy tones. Blooming in spring and on and off until frost, it is perfect for the front of a border or walkway.
