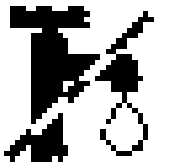


Blazing Stars/ Gayfeather



Liatris spicata ‘

- **Use:** They are equally at home in large, established perennial borders, where their thin, tall, airy floral wands create a mesmerizing "pop-up" effect. A clump forming perennial that has long lasting, fuzzy summer flowers in a pink-purple color. Attracts butterflies/ hummingbirds, deer resistant, and drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Looks best with occasional to regular irrigation.
- **Growth:** Grows upright to 3-4' tall with 1 1/2" wide
- **Hardiness:** 4-10, perennial
- **Foliage:** Thin green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Unusual spikes of purple flowers.



Super easy to grow and cheery, purple stalks attract butterflies.
