

Kobold Blazing Stars/ Gayfeather



Liatris spicata 'Kobold'

- **Use:** This more compact cultivar forms low grassy clumps which produce recurring spikes of showy pink blossoms. Naturally adapted to meadow gardens, but equally at home in sunny beds and borders. A long-lasting flower, excellent for cut flower arrangements. Attracts butterflies/ hummingbirds, deer resistant, and drought tolerant. Native plant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Looks best with occasional to regular irrigation.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 2 ft. tall, 1 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Thin green leaves. Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Unusual spikes of purple flowers.



Super easy to grow and cheery,
purple stalks attract butterflies.
