Broad, glossy, dark chocolate leaves with dark purple undersides make an extremely bold statement in the garden. In late summer, golden orange, daisy-like flowers are perched atop purplish-black stems for an all-together captivating composition. There's nothing quite like it!



Ligularia dentata 'Britt Marie Crawford'

- **Use:** A mound of dramatic dark chocolate-maroon foliage contrasts boldly with its yellow-orange daisy-like flowers. A natural for all beds and borders for contrast with green and lime foliage plants. Exceptional in containers. Fairly deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part shade in the South with some afternoon shade in the hottest months. Tolerant of wet soil and bogs. Also for use in rain gardens.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall, 2 to 3 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4a-9b; Perennial. Mulch around the plant in winter.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Broad, glossy, deep chocolate purple leaves.
- **Flower:** Golden orange, daisy-like flowers.
