> Great for cut flowers and very fragrant!

## Lilium orientalis 'First Romance'

- Use: This fragrant hybrid grows beautifully in the average garden, and its large, upfacing blooms on strong stems were outstanding as cut flowers. If you have ordered flowers from a florist's shop lately, you know it's still one of the best-selling Lilies (and fetches $\$ 6$ per stem in our part of the country). Bred to be shorter than Stargazer lilies with larger flowers.
- Exposure/Soil: Full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- Growth: Compact growth of 18 " tall and $8-10$ " wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-10; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Thin strap-like leaves.
- Flower: This fabulous Lily has brilliant cherry-pink flowers that are edged pure white and have a delightful fragrance.
