Lithodora diffusa 'Grace Ward'

- **Use:** This is an old rock garden favorite with deep cobalt-blue flowers, justly popular for nearly a century. Mounding stems with small, evergreen foliage form low, spreading hummocks that bloom late spring and early summer, in full sun and well-drained soil.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun with a little shade during the hot afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Take care to keep soil moist. Water under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Moderate-growing to 6-10" high, 2-3' wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Small leaves.
- **Flower:** True blue flowers from March until past July.
