

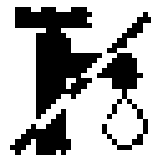
# Queen Victoria Cardinal Flower

## *Lobelia fulgens* 'Queen Victoria'

- **Use:** The most popular cardinal flower available! 'Queen Victoria' differs from the species in its vigor, tremendous flower output, and leaf color. Lobelia is an excellent border plant for moist locations and is a hummingbird magnet. Focal point plant in arresting red. This very dependable and vigorous selection will bloom even longer if you keep it dead headed. Hummingbird magnet! Cut flower.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established. Loves moisture but will tolerate it drier in part shade. This is a vigorous grower that performs best in moderately fertile, but well-drained soils.
- **Growth:** Grows quickly to 18-24" tall and plant them 12" apart.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Reddish bronze foliage.
- **Flower:** Brilliant red flower spikes from summer thru fall.
